False Alarm Prevention

The prevention of false alarms is an important issue, and your cooperation is needed to prevent needless responses by the authorities to your alarm and these false alarms can be financially costly to you.

Many local communities have adopted laws regulating alarm systems and providing for fines, or loss of police response, if your system generates too many false alarms. Your cooperation in carefully operating your alarm system can help prevent you from running afoul of your local regulations.

Most False Alarms Caused by Users

Extensive studies made throughout North America over the last few years show that over two thirds of false alarms are caused by user error, and that the vast majority of those needless alarms could have been easily prevented.
